CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS

provide the summaries of the proposed constitutional amendments that will appear on the
November 5, 2024, general election ballot for
consideration by the people of Georgia (short
captions are those adopted by the Constitutional Amendments Publication Board):

This proposal amends Article VII, Section II,

Paragraph II of the Georgia Constitution to
add a new subparagraph (a.1) to authorize the
General Assembly to provide by general law for
a state-wide uniform homestead exemption.

The law may limit this exemption to different
political subdivisions that do not already have

subting homestead exemptions, and may nopolitical subdivisions that do not already have existing homestead exemptions, and may provide for political subdivisions to opt out, or for future political subdivisions to opt in. Summary
This proposal creates a state-wide Georgia
Tax Court with state-wide jurisdiction for
use under certain circumstances. It contains
provisions relating to venue, jurisdiction, and
powers of such court. It provides for appointment of Georgia Tax Court judges with qualifications to be provided by law, and for filling
of vacancies.
