initial learning curve because I had to figure it out with the students. Most of the students did really well with it."

More technology savvy students had no problem adapting to the new learning style, and teachers found that to be supremely helpful with the more difficult classes such as math and science.

"It was a tough year," Eighth-Grade Teacher Ken Hamilton said. "It was tough for everyone, not just the students and teachers. I would say that the majority of the students did good with the move."

"They learned just like the teachers did. They might have known more, because usually if you have a question about the technology, you would just ask the kids."
