Football: Indians wrap up 2024 in low-scoring loss to Southeast Whitfield

Towns County was defeated by Southeast Whitfield County in the final game of the season last Friday, Oct 25th by a final score of 7-3. Nonetheless, it was a great defensive game.

Towns converted 13 first downs compared to Southeast with only 10, but Towns County was outgained in rushing yards, 154 to 131 yards. In passing yardage Towns compiled 107 yards to Southeast's 12, but the Indians couldn't capitalize in the red zone. Towns had 6 penalties for 57 yards and Southeast had 5 for 45 yards.

Still, there were some good individual highlights. Peyton McGaha completed 14 out of 25 for 107 yards. Alex Baert had 20 carries for 106 yards and Dustin Barrett had 12 carries for 48 yards. Grayson Youngblood made 6 catches for 36 yards.

Defensively, Morgan Walker made 10 tackles, Baert made 8 tackles and 3 were for a loss. Jacob Nicholson made 6 tackles and Wyatt Woody made 7 tackles and 1 was for a loss. Caden Coggins made the only score with a field goal from 24 yards and Reed Adams had a touchback kickoff.

The final season leaders had some excellent statistics. McGaha completed 74 of 126 passes for 768 yards, scored 3 touchdowns with 2 interceptions. Barrett had 162 carries for 962 yards rushing and scored 12 touchdowns. Baert
