## Kolby Moss chosen for BLITZ HOF



Kolby Moss' *BLITZ* Hall of Fame page reads, "Kolby Moss is an all-time great! He is a Towns County legend after leading the program to its first-ever State Championship in basketball. As a 4-year starter, the guard scored 1,887 career points, had 611 career rebounds, and averaged 17.8 points, 5.8 rebounds, 3.4 assists, and 1.1 steals per contest. He was the *BLITZ* Player of the Year after averaging 19.4 points per game as a senior. He averaged 23.1 as a junior, 18.9 as a sophomore, and 8.5 as a freshman. He was a 2-time All-State selection and multi 1st Team All-Region pick, as well as a 2-time Region POY. Moss went on to play basketball at Young Harris. Despite multiple ACL injuries that caused her to miss the equivalent of a FULL SEASON, she STILL scored over 1K points with 1,068 total (13.7 per game). The guard hauled in 479 boards (6.1 avg), had 220 assists (2.8), and 213 steals (2.7) for the Lady Indians.
